

The Painters are currently back in Australia for two years from 2017-2019.

Dave is studying a Master of Theology at Moore, reflecting on their last 17 years in Cambodia, and Leoni is studying a Bachelor of Theology.

Dave & Leoni plan to return to continue to serve in Cambodia with CMS from July 2019.

In Cambodia, Dave taught Biblical Theology in Khmer at Phnom Penh Bible School (PPBS) and developed and taught Moore College's PTC in Khmer to a group of young leaders. He led a team translating the New Bible Dictionary into Khmer in partnership with a local Christian publisher and preached at local churches.

Leoni led the Mekong Fellowship - a group of university students and graduates seeking to share the gospel on a local university campus. Leoni also taught Old Testament to first year students at PPBS.
